## BACKGROUND PAPERWORK

- 1. Certified copies of Complaint/Arrest Affidavit.
- 2. Certified copies of the Information, Indictment or other charging documents.
- 3. Certified copies of the Judgment and Sentence.
- 4. Certified copies of final disposition
- 5. Certified copy of Order Terminating Probation.
- 6. If adjudication of guilt was withheld, provide certified copies of Order Withholding Adjudication of Guilt and Placing Defendant on Probation.
- 7. If entered into Pre-Trial Program, provide certified copies of Order Placing Defendant in and completion of Pre-Trial Intervention or Diversion Program.
- 8. If civil rights were lost, provide evidence that they have been restored with a certified copy of application law enforcement agency form attesting that civil rights have been restored.
- 9. If records were sealed pursuant to Section 943, provide a certified copy of the Sealing or Expungement Order.
- 10. A written explanation outlining the events which let to each of the arrest/charges.

Certified means the document must bear the original seal and signature of the appropriate clerk or court. If no records are available, you must provide a certified letter from the clerk of courts stating that the records are not available.
